ORDINANCE NO. 12120

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO FRIENDS OF MOCCASIN BEND NATIONAL PARK THE AMOUNT OF THIRTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$30,000.00) TO FUND FIFTY PERCENT (50%) OF THE COST OF A FEASIBILITY STUDY TO HELP MEET REQUIREMENTS BY THE NATIONAL PARK SERVICE FOR THE CAPITAL CAMPAIGN AND BUILDING PROJECT FOR THE INTERPRETIVE CENTER AT THE MOCCASIN BEND NATIONAL ARCHEOLOGICAL DISTRICT, SUBJECT TO HAMILTON COUNTY CONTRIBUTING THE REMAINING FIFTY PERCENT (50%) OF THE COST OF SAID PROJECT.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That appropriation from the General Fund be and is hereby approved to Friends of Moccasin Bend National Park in the amount of \$30,000.00 to fund 50% of the cost of a feasibility study to help meet requirements by the National Park Service for the capital campaign and building project for the Interpretive Center at the Moccasin Bend National Archeological District, subject to Hamilton County contributing the remaining 50% of the cost for said project.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That, as a prerequisite of obtaining any funds from the City of Chattanooga, Friends of Moccasin Bend National Park shall file with the Mayor and City Council Clerk a copy of its charter filed with the State of Tennessee, a reference to the specific non-profit exemption under the Internal Revenue Code , copies of its annual budget and annual report of its business affairs and transactions, including its annual audit, its program of benefit to the residents of the City of Chattanooga, and its proposed usage of municipal assistance which can be reviewed by the public prior to the expenditure of any funds.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance shall take effect two (2) weeks from and after its passage.
