

RESOLUTION NO. 26049

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ROBERT B. DOAK TO USE TEMPORARILY THE RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR A SIGNAGE AT TEN (10) LOCATIONS FOR THE TENNESSEE CIVIL WAR TRAIL, AS SHOWN ON THE DRAWING ATTACHED HERETO AND MADE A PART HEREOF BY REFERENCE, SUBJECT TO CERTAIN CONDITIONS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE, That Robert B. Doak, (hereinafter referred to as "Temporary User") be and is hereby permitted to use temporarily the right-of-way for a signage at ten (10) locations for the Tennessee Civil War Trail, as shown on the drawing attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That said temporary usage shall be subject to the following conditions:

1. Temporary User must meet with Traffic Engineering to insure markers are placed as per city standards.
2. Temporary User shall execute the Indemnification Agreement attached hereto in favor of the City of Chattanooga, its officers, agents and employees for any and all claims for damages for injuries to persons or property related to or arising out of the temporary usage.
3. Temporary User agrees to vacate the property and temporary use upon reasonable notice from the City to do so.
4. Temporary User shall provide adequate access for maintenance of any utilities located within the easement.

INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

This Indemnification Agreement is entered into by and between THE CITY OF CHATTANOOGA, TENNESSEE (hereinafter the "City"), and ROBERT B. DOAK (hereinafter "Temporary User"), this 25th day of August, 2009.

For and in consideration of the granting of the temporary usage of the right-of-way for a signage at ten (10) locations for the Tennessee Civil War Trail, as shown on the drawing attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Temporary User agrees as follows:

1. Temporary User must meet with Traffic Engineering to insure markers are placed as per city standards.

2. Temporary User shall defend, and hold harmless the City of Chattanooga, Tennessee, its officers, agents and employees from any and all claims for damages for injuries to persons or property related to or arising out of the aforementioned temporary use.

3. Temporary User shall vacate the property and temporary use upon reasonable notice from the City to do so; the parties hereto agree that "reasonable notice" shall be deemed to be thirty (30) days. Temporary User shall restore the property to its original condition when it is returned to the City.


4. Temporary User shall provide adequate access for maintenance of any utilities located within the easement.


